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




## A Complete New Urban Neighborhood



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# Getting to Waterfront Square



### **Directions:**

#### **From Boston:**

Take the Sumner Tunnel or the Ted Williams Tunnel to Rte. 1A North. Follow Rte. 1A (William F McClellan Hwy) north for approx. 4 miles. At the Rte. 60 intersection, make a right turn to follow Rte. 1A (VFW Parkway) to Butler Circle. At the rotary continue north on Rte. 1A (North Shore Road). Wonderland Station is immediately on the right.

#### **From Logan Airport:**

Take the I-90 north toward Rte. 1A North. Follow Rte. 1A (William F McClellan Hwy) north for approx. 1 1/2 miles. At the Rte. 60 intersection, make a right turn to follow Rte. 1A (VFW Parkway) to Butler Circle. At the rotary continue north on Rte. 1A (North Shore Road). Wonderland Station is immediately on the right.

#### From the North Shore:

From Rte. 128/ 95 take Rte. 1 south for approx. 10 miles. Follow the Rte. 60/ Malden/ Revere ramp, turning left on Rte. 60 East (Squire Rd) for 1 mile. Continue left on Rte. 60 (American Legion Highway). At Timothy J Mahoney Circle, follow signs for Rte. 1A North (VFW Parkway) to the left. Follow Rte. 1A (VFW Parkway) to Butler Circle. At the rotary continue north on Rte. 1A (North Shore Road). Wonderland Station is immediately on the right.

### By MBTA:

Take the MBTA Blue Line outbound to Wonderland Station.
